- 2. What five criteria does Dahl identify as necessary for any regime to count as democratic? Do any of these strike you as odd or surprising?
- 3. Why are each of these required for political equality? Why, in particular, is control over the agenda important?
- 4. Should we be bothered by the likelihood that no actually existing polity is likely to meet the five criteria of a democracy?
- 5. Does the size of modern states make the quest for democracy impossible?
- 6. How well do you think the United States today fulfills these five criteria? Be specific.
