- 1. Why should we *not* assume today that the US Constitution is the best possible design for a democratic government? What does it have to do with knowledge?
- 2. Why might developments coming after the framing of the Constitution in 1787 be relevant for those who want to design a good constitution?
- 3. Which developments since 1787 does Dahl suggest might provide lessons for constitutional designers? Using whatever knowledge you have of these developments, what do you think designers might learn from them?
- 4. What immoveable constraints did the framers face when writing the Constitution according to Dahl?
- 5. What are the undemocratic features of the Constitution highlighted by Dahl? Are there any others you can think of? Which of these do you think is the problematic and why?
- 6. How, according to Dahl, does judicial power threaten democracy? What do you think of his argument here? Do you agree or disagree? Why?
